Blessing and Dismissal

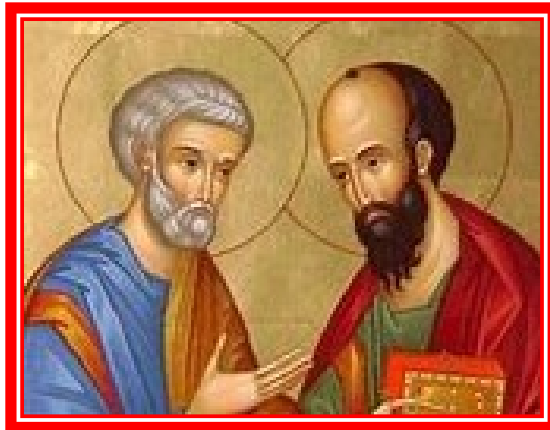
Recessional: Laudate. No 694
